Ordinance No. 4

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CONSTRUCTION, OR FACILITIES,
WITHIN GRANT COUNTY ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAYS.

Ordinance

The Grant County Board of Commissioners is hereby empowered to adopt rules and regulations concerning the construction and maintenance of utilities and other facilities within the Grant County Road rights-of-ways. These rules and regulations shall cover, but not be limited to, the following:

1. Minimum depth of underground utility lines;
2. Minimum height of above ground utility lines;
3. Location of utility poles;
4. Restriction governing fences on the right-of-way;
5. Permit requirements to cut county road;
6. Road restoration requirements;
7. Responsibilities for maintenance, or restoration of road drainage facilities.

Such rules and regulations to be adopted by the County Commissioners shall be published and made a matter of public record available for inspection at any time.
