## ORDINANCE NO. 00-06-27A

## OCCUPANT RESPONSIBILITY ORDINANCE

## (A) Definitions:

1. Occupant: Shall mean (1) the person or persons who own or are purchasing and reside in or at the dwelling place or premises at or on which the prohibited activities occur, or (2) the person or persons who have leased/rented and reside at or in the dwelling place or premises at or on which the prohibited activities occur, or (3) the person or persons exercising control over the dwelling place and/or premises.
2. Disorderly Conduct: Consists of any activity which is done, performed, or carried out in a violent, abusive, indecent, profane, boisterous, unreasonably loud or drunken, or otherwise disorderly manner which tends to disturb the peace.

(B) Prohibited Activities: It shall be unlawful for any person who is an occupant to permit, allow, keep, maintain, help, encourage or cause any disorderly conduct which tends to disturb the peace to occur at the dwelling place or premises where he/she resides.

(C) Penalty: Violations hereof are punishable by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) or imprisonment for ninety (90) days or both fine and imprisonment.
