Disaster Declaration Due to Fire

WHEREAS, the County of Grant has experienced significant fire activity since June 7, 2013, with the lightning caused Silver Fire; and


WHEREAS, damages to public property from this fire event have included substantial damage to roads (both paved and unpaved); and

WHEREAS, Grant County does not set aside funding in its annual budget to cover the cost of the extensive damages that have been incurred during these fire events; and

WHEREAS, Grant County must address the necessary public roadway repairs in the interests of the health, safety and welfare of its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Grant County Board of Commissioners hereby declares a disaster in Grant County due to the Silver Fire and hereby requests all available assistance from State and Federal resources in addressing the damages incurred, including any assistance that may be provided for Grant County and any private property owner who incurred damages due to the same fire event.


