RESOLUTION NO. R-13-44**

**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING PROCLAMATION DECLARING EXTREME OR
SEVERE DROUGHT CONDITIONS IN GRANT COUNTY—IMPOSITION OF
FIREWORKS RESTRICTIONS**

WHEREAS, on July 3, 2013, the Grant County Board of Commissioner (“Board”) held a special meeting at which the Board held a hearing pursuant to NMSA (1978) § 60-2C-8.1.E, to determine if fireworks restrictions should be imposed within the unincorporated portions of the County due to extreme or severe drought conditions;

WHEREAS, after the hearing on July 3, 2013, the Board found that extreme or severe drought conditions existed within Grant County;


WHEREAS, as a result of its findings, the Board adopted a Proclamation Declaring Extreme or Severe Drought Conditions in Grant County—Imposition of Fireworks Restrictions (“Proclamation”); and

WHEREAS, the Board held an emergency hearing on July 18, 2013, to determine if the weather and fire conditions have improved since it adopted the Proclamation.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Board finds that the weather and fire conditions have improved such that the Proclamation Declaring Extreme or Severe Drought Conditions in Grant County—Imposition of Fireworks Restrictions, adopted on July 3, 2013, is no longer warranted.
2. That effective immediately, the Proclamation is rescinded.
