

RESOLUTION #13-49

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF GRANT AND THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ROADS WITHIN GRANT COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the County of Grant requests a cooperative agreement with the New Mexico Department of Transportation under the School Bus Routes program to patch roadway where needed and lay single penetration chip seal with drainage improvements and striping – Little Walnut Road – B.O.P. starting at cattle guard North .84 miles to E.O.P.; Ridge Road – B.O.P. starting at City Limits sign south 1.98 miles to E.O.P. at end of pavement; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated amount of these projects is \$73,720.00 in which the NMDOT will fund \$55,290.00 (75%) and the county will match \$18,430.00 (25%). and,

WHEREAS, funds, equipment, labor and materials representing the County's share will be available when the agreement becomes effective, and will remain readily available until agreement is completed or legally terminated, and

WHEREAS, funds representing the County's share of the agreement will be budgeted for, available and payable upon completion of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Grant County Commissioners to enter into Cooperative Agreement project Number SB-7717(930) 14. Control Number HW2 L100140 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF Project for year 2013 – 2014 to patch roadway where needed and lay single penetration chip seal with drainage and shoulder improvements and striping – Little Walnut Road – B.O.P. starting at cattle guard North .84 miles to E.O.P.; Ridge Road – B.O.P. starting at City Limits sign south 1.98 miles to E.O.P. at end of pavement.




