ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR
COUNTY ELECTED OFFICIALS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1: TITLE AND AUTHORITY.- This Resolution may be cited as the "GRANT County Elected Officials Salary Resolution" and is adopted pursuant to Section 4-37-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1975, Chapter 312) and Section 4-44-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1986, Chapter 67).

Section 2: DECLARATION OF PURPOSE.- Article X, Section 1 of the New Mexico Constitution requires the Legislature to classify counties and fix salaries for county officers. Section 4-44-2 NMSA 1978 set the maximum salaries authorized by the Legislature for the variously classified counties.

It is therefore the purpose of this Resolution to establish salaries for elected county officers which do not exceed the maximum salaries established by law.

Section 3: SALARIES.- The following annual salaries are established for the year beginning January 1, 1991, and all years following, unless changes are made by law that would require an amendment of this Resolution.


A. Commissioners: \$14,030 or \$42,090 for three
B. Treasurer: \$35,190
C. Assessor: \$35,190
D. Sheriff: \$36,685
E. Clerk: \$35,190
F. Probate Judge: \$12,305


