RESOLUTION NO. 91-12-05C

PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, Section 4-38-3 New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1978 Compilation was amended by Laws 1985, Chapter 204, to require Counties with a population greater than thirteen thousand (13,000) to be divided into as many compact single-member districts as there are board members, to be elected from each district by the votes of the district, and to reside within the district from which he is elected;

WHEREAS, Grant County has a population greater than thirteen thousand (13,000), based on the 1990 federal census;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County that three compact districts be created, as equal in population as possible, as follows:

- A. County Commission District 1 shall be composed of Grant County precinct number 8, 16, 17, 19, 21, 22, 23, 24, 32, 33, and 34.
- B. County Commission District 2 shall be composed of Grant County precinct number 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31.
- C. County Commission District 3 shall be composed of Grant County precinct number 1, 2, 12, 13, 14, 15, 18, and 20.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the three districts shall be composed of the precincts in existence on the effective date of this Resolution:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the three districts hereby created shall be applicable to the 1992 primary and general elections, and all future elections, unless amended by law or resolution;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that once following publication of the official report of each federal decennial census hereafter conducted, the Board of County Commissioners shall, by resolution, re-district the county commission pursuant to Section 4-38-3 NMSA 1978.
