WHEREAS, Grant County is in the State of New Mexico and is within 30 miles from the United States/Mexico border; and

WHEREAS, certain communities in Grant County were in existence prior to October 1, 1989; and


WHEREAS, these certain communities often lack basic public facilities such as potable water supply, adequate sewage systems and decent, safe and sanitary housing.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Commission hereby:


1. Assures the United State Department of Agriculture that these communities qualify as "colonias" for the purpose of qualifying for project funding governed by Section 916 of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act.
2. Vests the County Manager with the responsibility, authority and means to:
 - a. Cooperate with state and federal officials in development of the program for Grant County colonias.
 - b. Assure that future development within Grant County will be controlled to prevent establishment of new colonias.
 - c. Commit to the securement of matching funds.
 - d. Coordinate active involvement among all government entities within the County.
3. Agrees to take such other official action as may be necessary to carry out the objectives of the program.




