WHEREAS, New Mexico State Law 1-9-5 requires that the counties maintain sufficient voting machines relative to the number of registered voters at the close of registration, and


WHEREAS, the County Clerk of Grant County has informed the Board of County Commissioners that the County will not be in compliance with New Mexico State Law 1-9-5 because of the Precinct Readjustment Boundary Act, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have deemed it in the best interest of the county to purchase eighteen (18) additional Election, Recording and Tabulating Voting Machines.

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved that the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County propose to purchase eighteen (18) electronic recording and tabulating voting machines.


UNANIMOUSLY PROPOSED, approved and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County on this 2nd day of May, 1991.
