CONCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC HEARING

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF GRANT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS held a public hearing on December 22, 1993 and is attached hereto as Exhibit A, to receive any protest or objection questioning the:

- 1.) propriety and advisability of constructing the improvement;
- 2.) estimated cost of the improvement
- 3.) manner of paying for the improvement; or
- 4.) estimated maximum benefit to each individual tract or parcel of land.

WHEREAS, the Board did receive protest on assessment cost and the County Engineer made corrections to various assessments and are made part of this resolution and is attached hereto AND

WHEREAS, the assessed cost the affected homeowners is the cost of materials and the cost of construction of the paved aprons but does not include the cost of any work performed by the Road Department AND

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners during the hearing did not receive any protest on the construction of the improvement or the type and character of the Improvement, NOW

THEREFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, by this resolution concludes the hearing, finds the improvements as described by the Engineer's Plans and filed in the Office of the County Clerk Book of Ordinances, book 204 pages 640 thru 650 with the corrections, Exhibit B of this resolution, are advisable and should be made and orders that the Provisional Order #92-11-19 Exhibit C of this resolution, creating the Indian Hills and Little Walnut Mobile Ranch Subdivisions Improvement District be made permanent. The Board of County Commissioners hereby instructs the County Manager to:

- 1.) Solicit for competitive bids on the placement of paved aprons.




