Chairman Serna called the hearing to order at 10:00 a.m.

Chairman Serna asked the County Engineer to briefly explain the improvement for Indian Hills and Little Walnut Mobile Ranch Subdivision and the cost to the affected property owners. Dennis Wagner representing Engineers Inc., stated the following, the improvement district was created to correct drainage problems throughout the subdivisions. These drainage improvements will be needed along with the construction that will be performed by the developer as a result of a settlement agreement with the County.

Mrs. Dominguez, Ordinance Officer, further stated that the County also had a share in the cost of the improvement.

Mr. Serna then asked for any public comments.

Mr. Donald Glen approach the Commission and Mr. Wagner asking them if there was any surveying done on his property and why he was not sent a notice on the hearing. Mr. Wagner explained that Mr. Glen's property

did not need any improvements and his property was surveyed. Mr. Glen was satisfied with the explanation.


Mr. McGee, Arrowhead Road, asked why the Engineers planned such a wide driveways for his property. He requested that they be narrowed down from a combination of 30' & 26'. Mr. McGee was of the opinion that the culvert width were excessive. Mr. Wagner said that he would go to the site again and work out an adjustment with Mr. McGee.


Mr. Richard Grandi expressed his favoritism towards the need of the improvement of his property.

Mrs. Helen Worthington approached the Commission & Mr. Wagner asking them for two culverts on her property. Mr. Wagner state that he would go out to the site and re-evaluate the need for a second culvert.

Mr. William Roberts asked why a culvert was not being installed on his property. Mr. Wagner stated that one was not needed and the existing culvert would just need some maintenance by the Mr. Roberts and when the road department takes over the maintenance of the road the department will clean out the culvert. Mr. Roberts was satisfied.

Chairman Serna Moved to Adjourn the hearing with any other comments or questions. Mr. Diaz SECONDED. MOTION CARRIED.



