

RESOLUTION #96-05-23-C

Road Acceptance for Indian Hills Roads

WHEREAS, Grant County has been petitioned to accept certain roads in Indian Hills Subdivision #3 and 4, for inclusion into the Grant County Road System, for maintenance AND,

WHEREAS, the roads in the subdivision are depicted in Exhibit A and are dedicated for public use in the Grant County Clerk's records and defined more specifically as follows:

6. Copper Ridge Road (formerly named Burning Tree Lane)	.12 miles	50'	6 41
7. Briarwood Lane (formerly named Burning Tree Road)	.30 miles	60'	6 41

for an total of approximately 1.32 miles NOW

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF GRANT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DID accept 1.32 miles of roads in Indian Hills Subdivisions #3 & 4, into the Grant County Road System for maintenance as described above, at their regular meeting of May 9th 1996.


