




T17S, R14W, Sec.22&23

1 INCH : 650 FEET




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

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

Dear Tim,

It is recommended that the county accept the remainder of Cottonwood, south of Schiff Trail, to where it connects to cottonwood off Cain Drive.

We also recommend the owner provide re-platting of subdivision to allow the county to properly maintain the roadway, ditches and culverts.

The properties on west side of roadway north of Arrowhead/Palo Verde intersection were known to have a problem. The property on the southeast corner of Cottonwood and Schiff Trail had a similar problem.

We agree with Mr. Sanchez that the concrete placed on outlet side of triple culverts should be repaired with asphalt.

This area needs signs, delineators (at culverts) and guard-rails at triple culverts (both sides) and double culverts (west side) and other locations to be determined by County Road Dept.
