

RESOLUTION # 97-09-11A

PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE TRAFFIC
STUDY
SILVER CITY - GRANT COUNTY

WHEREAS, the streets and roads of Grant County and its environs are becoming congested as a consequence of rapid growth in the area; and

WHEREAS, Grant County received a \$200,000.00 grant from the New Mexico State Highway Department to perform a traffic study; and

WHEREAS, Engineers, Inc. was contracted to perform the study and to make recommendations to improve the traffic circulation of Grant County and its environs; and

WHEREAS, the study was performed over a period of 16 months with numerous public meetings to provide opportunities for citizen participation and review; and


WHEREAS, a technical advisory committee was established with the approval of the participating entities, including the County of Grant to direct the study, which included representatives from the County, the Town, Region V of the Council of Governments, the District Engineer's Office of the New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department, as well as the Advanced Planning Division of that Department; and


WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Technical Advisory Committee that the traffic plan as developed by Engineers, Inc. be adopted.


