**WHEREAS,** the Board of Grant County Commissioners ("Commission") states that all voting machines are in the custody of the Grant County Clerk; and

**WHEREAS,** Grant County has thirty-nine (39) electronic 1242 voting machines with impact printers; and


**WHEREAS,** the Commission requests to upgrade the thirty-nine (39) impact printers and convert them to thermal printers; and

**WHEREAS,** the Commission deems it necessary to request thirty-nine (39) thermal conversions at \$1,497.83 each for a total cost of \$58,415.37 from the Voting Machine Revolving Fund;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commission, as the governing body of Grant County, that it formally submit a request through the New Mexico State Board of Finance to do a thermal conversion on thirty-nine (39) electronic 1242 voting machines to conduct more efficient elections.


