GRANT COUNTY GOVERNING POLICY

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Grant County is the legislative body of County Government consisting of three (3) elected officials with legislative powers for taxing, issuing bonds, zoning and approving ordinances, in addition to numerous executive and administrative duties as specified by law, and

WHEREAS, other Elected Officials and Department Heads are involved in the day to day operations of County government, and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Grant County have hired a County Manager to act as the administrative assistant to the Board of County Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is required to govern the County as a body.





