RESOLUTION 00-08-30

WHEREAS, Grant County has suffered severe damage caused by a flash flood on or about July 1st, 2000; and,

WHEREAS, Extensive damage was caused to a number of community ditches on the Mimbres River, and


WHEREAS, The incident has resulted in undue human suffering and hardship and threatens the safety, health, welfare, and well-being of the citizens and local economy of Grant County; and,


WHEREAS, All locally available public and private resources and forces available to mitigate and alleviate the damage have been insufficient to cope with the resulting situation, make repairs, and meet public safety requirements;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Grant County Commission, by virtue of the authority provided by Grant County Ordinance 95-04-20A titled "Civil Preparedness," and by the New Mexico Civil Emergency Preparedness Act (NMSA 1978, 12-10-01 to 12-10-11) do hereby declare Grant County to be under a state of Disaster, for the purpose of exercising necessary emergency powers and expenditure of available local resources and for requesting aid, assistance, relief programs, and funding that may be available from the state of New Mexico.




