Adjustments to Precinct Boundaries

WHEREAS, in order to meet requirements for the Primary and General Elections for the year 2002, certain adjustments of precinct boundaries are being proposed by the county clerk of Grant County, Pursuant to NMSA Section 1-3-1 et seq.. (1978); and

WHEREAS, NMSA Section 1-3-1 et seq. (1978) of the New Mexico Election Code, empowers the board of county commissioners to create, organize, change, combine or divide Precincts; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the New Mexico election Code, The County Clerk has made a determination that Precincts 5,8,9,11,26,27 must be adjusted; and

WHEREAS, these changes are being recommended in order to meet the requirements of the Election Code and prepare for the Primary and General election in the year 2002, and the upcoming redistricting reapportionment. The recommended changes by the County Clerk along with a map are attached as Exhibit "A"- "F" respectively.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Grant County Commission does hereby endorse and approve the changes to the precincts and existing precincts attached in the exhibit "A"-“F”.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution together with exhibit "A"-"F" be forwarded to the Secretary of State, the County Chairman to each political party, and published once in the News Paper of General circulation as defined in NMSA Section 1-3-8 (1978). In addition, any and all voters affected will be notified at the completion of the redistricting process by the County Clerk's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be recorded in the office of the Grant County Clerk.
