

RESOLUTION NO. 01-07-16

WHEREAS, the County of Grant has declared an emergency based on the devastating financial condition it is in, and;

WHEREAS, effective June 29 approximately 36 employees were laid off due to the financial emergency, and;

WHEREAS, the financial situation has not improved for Grant County, and rather has become more devastating for the short term, and;

WHEREAS, without taking drastic measures the Board of County Commission will be unable to make payroll through the next three (3) months;


BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of County Commission directs that the following actions will be taken immediately:

1. Grant County exempt and non-exempt Administrative Complex, Grant County Road Department, Grant County Sheriff Department, and Grant County Detention employee's work week will be reduced to a thirty-two (32) hour week. The Administrative Complex and the Road Department will be closed every Friday beginning July 20, 2001. The Sheriff Department and Detention Center will be off as scheduled by the department to reflect the thirty-two (32) hour work week.
2. Those employees with set salaries will incur a twenty (20%) percent pay decrease. This will include elected officials, administrative, hourly paid, appointed, salaried and professional employees (attorney employment contract will be amended reflecting the diminishment in pay).
3. All travel or per diem is prohibited unless approved by the Grant County Board of County Commission.
4. No benefits or conditions of employment shall be affected and 32 hours shall be considered full time during this schedule.


5. The resolution shall be in duration for three (3) months after adoption and based on the County's financial status. Negotiations for an extension to the agreement will start a week prior to the initial resolution termination date.

Resolved this 16th day of July, 2001.




