

**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT
ALL MAIL BALLOT SPECIAL ELECTION**

NO.01-07-26B

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 01-07-24 the Grant County Board of County Commissioners did resolve that a Special Election shall be called for September 25, 2001 for the purpose of imposing a one-eighth of one percent (1/8 of 1%) of the gross receipts tax in the unincorporated area of the county; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of the this tax is to keep the Juvenile Detention Center operating and certified; and,


WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Grant County Clerk that an all-mailed ballot special election is in the best interest of the voters of Grant County; and,


WHEREAS, The Mail Ballot Election Act requires that each registered votes of the of the county shall be mailed an absentee ballot along with a statement that there will be no polling place for the election; and;


WHEREAS, the Mail Ballot Election Act requires the ballot shall be mailed to each voter no earlier than August 21, 2001 and the mailing shall be completed by September 20, 2001.

THEREFORE be it Resolved that the Special Election of September 25th, 2001 wherein the question is whether to impose of one-eighth of one percent (1/8 of 2 percent) of gross receipts tax for the purpose of the continued operation and certification of the Juvenile Detention center shall be conducted as a Mail Ballot Election.
