

**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT  
ALL MAIL BALLOT SPECIAL ELECTION**

NO.01-07-26B

**WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 01-07-24 the Grant County Board of County Commissioners did resolve that a Special Election shall be called for September 25, 2001 for the purpose of imposing a one-eighth of one percent (1/8 of 1%) of the gross receipts tax in the unincorporated area of the county; and,**

**WHEREAS, the purpose of the this tax is to keep the Juvenile Detention Center operating and certified; and,**


**WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Grant County Clerk that an all-mailed ballot special election is in the best interest of the voters of Grant County; and,**

**WHEREAS, The Mail Ballot Election Act requires that each registered votes of the of the county shall be mailed an absentee ballot along with a statement that there will be no polling place for the election; and;**

**WHEREAS, the Mail Ballot Election Act requires the ballot shall be mailed to each voter no earlier than August 21, 2001 and the mailing shall be completed by September 20, 2001.**

**THEREFORE be it Resolved that the Special Election of September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2001 wherein the question is whether to impose of one-eighth of one percent (1/8 of 2 percent) of gross receipts tax for the purpose of the continued operation and certification of the Juvenile Detention center shall be conducted as a Mail Ballot Election.**


