

**RESOLUTION NO. R-02-03**

**A Resolution Supporting a Legislative Appropriation for Corre  
Caminos Transit**

**WHEREAS, Corre Caminos Transit began operating January 29, 2001 after this community determined there was a tremendous need for public transportation; and,**

**WHEREAS, Corre Camino Transit is the only public transportation service available in Grant County; and,**

**WHEREAS, Corre Camino Transit provides transportation for Welfare to Work participants in the counties of Grant, Luna and Hildago, enabling single mothers, otherwise without transportation, to attend school and work; and,**

**WHEREAS, seventy percent of the funding of Corre Caminos is provided by the federal government with a local cash match requirement of \$90,000; and,**


**WHEREAS, recent severe economic difficulties in Grant County have made it very difficult to raise the money required for the match; and,**

**WHEREAS, without the \$90,000 match requirement Corre Caminos Transit risks losing its operating system which will result in the loss of 2 full time and 11 part time employees and \$427,00 in federal money; and,**

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners requests that the Grant County Legislative Delegation support Corre Caminos request for a \$90,000 appropriation for the purpose of the cash match requirement.**




