**WHEREAS** Senator Jeff Bingaman plans to introduce legislation to designate Fort Bayard as a National Historic Landmark; and


**WHEREAS** such designation would provide not only recognition of the site's historic value but also potential funding for its restoration;

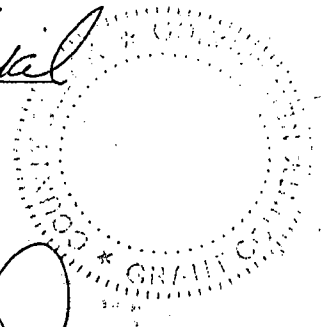

Approved and adopted on this 23rd Day of May, 2002, in an open meeting of the Grant County Commission.






