

Grant County - Resolution No. R-02-31

Resolution Adopting An Infrastructure Capital Improvements Plan (ICIP)

WHEREAS, Grant County recognizes that the financing of public capital projects has become a major concern in New Mexico and nationally; and

WHEREAS, in times of scarce resources, it is necessary to find new financing mechanisms and maximize the use of existing resources; and

WHEREAS, systematic capital improvements planning is an effective tool for communities to define their development needs, establish priorities and pursue concrete actions and strategies to achieve necessary project development; and

WHEREAS, this process contributes to local and regional efforts in project identification and selection in short and long-range capital planning efforts.

WHEREAS, Grant County encourages their volunteer fire departments to participate in the Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan process.

WHEREAS, the Cliff-Gila, Tyrone, Pinos Altos, Ft. Bayard, Sapillo, Santa Rita, Whiskey, Upper Mimbres and Lower Mimbres Volunteer Fire Departments have completed their Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY GRANT COUNTY THAT:

2. The County has also adopted the attached Infrastructure Capital Improvements Plan for the nine county volunteer fire departments listed above.


3. It is intended that the Plan be a working document and is the first of many steps toward improving rational, long-range capital planning and budgeting for New Mexico's infrastructure.


