WHEREAS, Section 4-44-4.1 NMSA 1978 establishes a maximum salary for the elected county offices of Assessor, Clerk, Commissioner, Sheriff, Treasurer, and Probate Judge; and,


WHEREAS, the County of Grant wishes to revise the salary structure for elected county officials in accordance with the standards established by law;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Grant County Board of Commissioners, that the following salaries are established effective January 1, 2005. This revised salary structure shall take effect upon the initiation of a new term of office for each position, on a date subsequent to the approval of this resolution.

Clerk	\$47,631.10/year
Commissioner	\$18,990.40/year
Sheriff	\$49,655.10/year
Treasurer	\$47,631.10/year
Probate Judge	\$16,655.10/year


