**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A REGIONAL GRANT APPLICATION TO
THE NEW MEXICO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT FOR THE
PARTICIPATION IN THE SIROLI INSTITUTE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Sirolli Institute was introduced to Grant County through the New Mexico Economic Development Department in an effort to promote economic development in our area; and

WHEREAS, the Sirolli Institute is an organization that relies upon community involvement in concert with existing economic development efforts to assist entrepreneurs by introducing Enterprise Facilitation to communities who are seeking to grow their economies from within; and

WHEREAS, through the Enterprise Facilitator, individuals in our community can receive free, confidential business management and networking advice; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Grant County Commission that economic stability in our community be developed, not just through the recruitment of new businesses to the area, but through the expansion and development of local businesses; and


WHEREAS, the New Mexico Economic Development Department is offering one grant to cover 66% of the costs of the program for three years for the successful applicant; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Grant County Commission that the County wishes to participate in the application for the grant from the New Mexico Economic Development Department and supports economic growth and, therefore, agrees on the benefits it will bring to Southwest New Mexico.
