A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2004 GRANT COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Grant County Board of Commissioners desires to update the 1994 Comprehensive Plan. The 1994 Comprehensive Plan was adopted by Ordinance #94-06-16 and the Board of County Commissioners is now desirous of adopting the 2004 Comprehensive Plan by resolution; and

WHEREAS, Community Development Block Grant funds were obtained to hire a consultant to prepare the update; and

WHEREAS, citizens of Grant County were selected to serve on the Grant County Comprehensive Task Force Board, to work with the County's Consultant to update the County's 1994 Comprehensive Plan and


