ELECTED OFFICIALS SALARIES

WHEREAS, the salaries of elected officials are regulated according to New Mexico State Statutes; and,

WHEREAS, Section 4-44-4.1 NMSA 1978 establishes a maximum salary for the elected county offices of Assessor, Clerk, Commissioner, Sheriff, Treasurer, and Probate Judge; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Grant had previously reduced the salaries of its elected officials in response to a financial crisis; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Grant has subsequently resolved its financial concerns to the level where it has approved pay increases for its regular employees; and,


WHEREAS, the County of Grant wishes to reestablish the pay levels of its elected officials.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Grant County Board of County Commissioners, that the following describes the revised and current salary structure for the elected positions as listed. In accordance with New Mexico Law, this revised salary structure shall take effect upon the initiation of a new term of office for each position, on a date subsequent to the approval of this resolution.

Assessor	\$43,301/year
Clerk	\$43,301/year
Commissioner	\$17,264/year
Sheriff	\$45,141/year
Treasurer	\$43,301/year
Probate Judge	\$15,141/year
