

RESOLUTION #R-03-09

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Legislature has amended the Per Diem and Mileage Act (Section 10-8-1 through 10-8-8, NMSA and Amendments thereto) effective July 1, 2003, providing for increases in the allowable per diem and mileage paid to public officials and employees, and

WHEREAS, the amended law also provides for a greater per diem payment in high cost areas as determined by the governing body of local governments, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Grant County Commissioners wishes to designate the City of Santa Fe as a high cost area for the purpose of establishing the payment of per diem for the public officials and employees of the County of Grant, and

WHEREAS, the following out-of-state municipalities shall be high cost areas: New York City, Washington DC, Los Angeles and San Francisco, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Grant County Commissioners wishes to authorize new per diem rates as follows:

In State but Away From Home Per Diem

All Employees in a Normal Cost Area	\$ 75.00
All Employees in a High Cost Area	\$ 95.00

Out of State Per Diem

All Officials and Employees in a Normal Cost Area	\$ 95.00
All Officials and Employees in a High Cost Area	\$115.00

Mileage

Cents Per Mile for Use of Personal Vehicles	\$.32

Partial Per Diem Rate

Per diem for travel not requiring overnight lodging, but extending beyond a normal work day will be calculated as follows:

2 hours to less than 6 hours beyond normal work day	\$ 8.00
6 hours to less than 12 hours beyond normal work day	\$ 16.00
12 hours or more beyond normal work day	\$ 22.50


Partial day per diem for last day travel on overnight trips will be calculated on hours in excess of 24-hour increments as follows:


2 hours to less than 6 hours beyond 24-hr increment	\$ 8.00
6 hours to less than 12 hours beyond 24-hr increment	\$ 16.00
12 hours or more beyond 24-hr increment	\$ 22.50

Reimbursement for actual meal expenses will be limited to \$30.00 for 12 hours or more beyond the normal work day or beyond the 24-hour increments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF GRANT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS hereby adopted and approved said resolution on this 24th day of July 2003.




