WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico, through its Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) program, will reimburse Grant County for fifty percent of an employee's salary and benefits, providing that the employees duties focus on Emergency Management; and,

WHEREAS, the EMPG program attempts to mitigate the affects of natural and manmade disasters upon the local jurisdiction through training, planning, and coordination of available resources; and,

WHEREAS, the Gila Regional Medical Center is a component unit of Grant County; and,


WHEREAS, the Gila Regional Medical Center wishes to fund the remaining fifty percent of an Emergency Managers salary in order to promote the program's continuance in Grant County;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County, New Mexico, that:

- 2) The position created through this program will be located within the personnel structure of Gila Regional Medical Center.
- 3) The Gila Regional Medical Center will provide the matching funds necessary for participation in the EMPG program.
- 4) The position of Emergency Manager created through the EMPG grant shall be oriented towards the benefits of all citizens of Grant County.


