Resolution # R-03-30

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Grant County, New Mexico are committed to promoting the health, safety, and welfare of their constituents; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Grant has held three public hearings in order to solicit input from the public regarding the 2004 Community Development Block Grant cycle; and,

WHEREAS, The Southwest Advocates for Kids (SWAK) is a non-profit organization serving the needs of area youth and families; and,

WHEREAS, the SWAK is presently housed in leased facilities which require that operational funds go towards lease payments in lieu of additional services; and,

WHEREAS, the SWAK Board has determined that local properties available for sale would provide for the needs of the organization while reducing expenses; and,

WHEREAS, the SWAK has requested assistance from the County of Grant in the purchase of permanent facilities through the CDBG process; and,

WHEREAS, the SWAK has committed to providing the 10% matching funds required for CDBG application.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County, New Mexico, that:

- 2) The application to be submitted will be for \$500,000 for the purchase of facilities to house the SWAK and its programs.


