Resolution in Support of Wastewater Recycling by the City of Bayard

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Grant County, New Mexico are committed to protecting the health, safety, and welfare of their constituents; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bayard has been pursuing the development of a new wastewater treatment facility, and is now prepared to begin construction on this project; and,

WHEREAS, the addition of tertiary filters to the new wastewater treatment facility would provide a source of usable, recycled water for the City of Bayard and surrounding communities; and,


WHEREAS, this recycled water would require the development of infrastructure in order to provide a distribution system for this valuable resource; and,


WHEREAS, funds for the development of this necessary infrastructure are now being sought through legislative resources; and,


WHEREAS, the County of Grant has committed to utilizing recycled water for its Bataan Memorial Park facility, providing the water can be delivered,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County, New Mexico, that the County of Grant supports the request for funds from the New Mexico State Legislature (and other potential sources) for the purpose of installing tertiary filters at the wastewater facility and developing a distribution system for recycled wastewater in and around the City of Bayard, New Mexico.

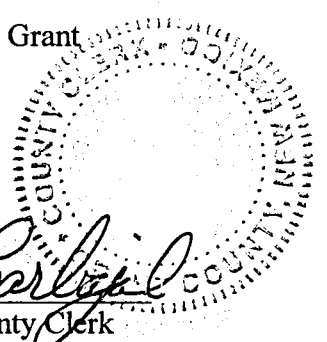
