

RESOLUTION #R-05-36

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF GRANT AND THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ROADS WITHIN GRANT COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the County of Grant requests a cooperative agreement with the New Mexico Department of Transportation under the School Bus Routes program to reconstruct roadway with low water crossing and Central Plant Cold Recycling, culvert installation and drainage improvements on Mangus Valley Road. The estimated amount is \$103,800.00 in which the NMSHTD will fund \$77,850.00 (75%) and the county will match \$25,950.00 (25%). Vendor# 5114463, Project# SB-7717 (922) 06, Control# 87142.




