**Whereas,** the Governor's Investment Plan (GRIP) has provided for more than one billion dollars for state highways; and

**Whereas,** other critical street, road and bridge projects not designated in GRIP still need to be addressed; and

**Whereas,** these projects are important for economic development within Grant County; and

**Whereas,** it is not enough to have an efficient state highway system, but rather it is essential that an effective, efficient transportation system be in place within municipalities and counties in order to provide for the safe and efficient movement of people, goods and services; and


**Whereas,** transportation should be viewed not just as the state highway system, but as a complete network of state, county streets, roads, bridges, rail and transit.


**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** that Grant County supports GRIP 2 funding for critical local projects and specifically, the Roadway rehabilitation for Rosedale Road in the amount of \$960,000.00, to follow, be guided by and adhere to current state transportation improvement plans established by Metropolitan Planning Organizations and Regional Planning Organizations; and


**Be It Further Resolved** that a comprehensive plan of investment for critical transportation projects be developed with county input and that such plan identify funding resources necessary to finance such plan; and

**Be It Further Resolved** that New Mexico counties and specifically, Grant County, the Governor and the Legislature collaborate on the development of critical local transportation projects and a comprehensive investment plan.
