**A RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR A 2007 COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT UNDER COLONIAS SET-ASIDE**

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Grant County, desires to apply for a 2007 Community Development Block Grant and make such application to the State of New Mexico, and

WHEREAS, The County of Grant has held four (4) public hearings in order to solicit input from the Public regarding the 2007 Community Development Block Grant cycle; and,

WHEREAS, The County of Grant will modify the current wastewater treatment collection system in North Hurley, and

WHEREAS, The County of Grant encourages regionalization of wastewater systems; and

WHEREAS, North Hurley is a colonias designated area; and

WHEREAS, North Hurley meets the low/moderate income eligibility; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Grant County assures and certifies that it will comply with the regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements with respect to the acceptance and use of state funds for this program,

WHEREAS, it is the majority opinion of the Board of Commissioners of Grant County that the proposed grant will be in the best interest of the residents of the community, now, therefore,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County, New Mexico, that:

1. The County of Grant wishes to submit an application for the 2007 CDBG funding cycle.
2. The County of Grant authorizes Henry Torres, Commission Chair to sign the application.
