
**WHEREAS**, individuals in Grant County express interest in developing their personal skills and potential leadership abilities; and,

**WHEREAS**, national studies indicate formal leadership programs enhance individual growth and community development.



**APPROVED AND ADOPTED** in a regular meeting of the Grant County Board of Commissioners this 9<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2007.


