**DESIGNATING THE SUBDIVISION OF TROUT VALLEY
 A "COLONIA" WITHIN GRANT COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the Grant County Commission wishes to designate the subdivision of Trout Valley a "Colonia" as defined by the Federal government, and

WHEREAS, Trout Valley is located within 150 miles of the United States-Mexico border and has been in existence prior to October 1, 1989, and


WHEREAS, Trout Valley often lacks adequate potable water supply, adequate sewage system.


WHEREAS, designation as a "Colonia" is necessary before certain state and federal funds can be made available to improve infrastructure within Trout Valley;

PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED this 23 day of August. 2007.


