RESOLUTION #R-07-50

**DECLARING THE INTENT TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE FOR A FIVE-MEMBER
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; REQUIREMENT OF UNANIMOUS
VOTE; PROVISION FOR THE DIVISION OF THE COUNTY INTO FIVE
COMMISSION DISTRICTS.**

WHEREAS, Article X Section 7 of the New Mexico Constitution, as amended, provides that the Board of County Commissioners may be increased from three to five members; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Grant County Commissioners shall conduct a public hearing on at a later advertised date to discuss and receive public input regarding an Ordinance for a five member commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Grant County Commissioners shall meet in a regular County Commission meeting at date to be published after the public hearing to approve or disapprove the adoption of the Ordinance.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF GRANT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that said Resolution #R-07-49 declares the intent to adopt an ordinance for a five-member board of Grant County Commissioners.
