AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. R-07-38 REMOVING A PORTION OF TYRONE THOMPSON  
ROAD FROM THE GRANT COUNTY ROAD INVENTORY TROUGH ABANDONMENT

WHEREAS, the Grant County Board of County Commissioners has considered the issue of abandoning the road listed below:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the County of Grant, State of New Mexico that portion of Tyrone Thompson Road described as "5 miles of roadway beginning .8 miles from the Hidalgo County line north on Tyrone Thompson Road" is hereby abandoned and removed from the Grant County Road Inventory for the listed reason.


Reason for abandonment:
