SUPPORT OF STATE AND FEDERAL FIRE RESTRICTIONS

**WHEREAS** Grant County has been suffering from reduced rainfall amounts for the past and current years; and,

**WHEREAS** this lack of precipitation has resulted in drought conditions that pose significant problems for the citizens of Grant County; and,

**WHEREAS** the State Forestry and United States Forest Service are currently under Stage 1 fire restrictions for the Gila National Forest and public and private lands in New Mexico; and,

**WHEREAS** the Commission believes that the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the county is a top priority; and,

**WHEREAS** The County has been lucky this year to have not experienced the severe fires other western states are experiencing.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Grant County Board of Commissioners in an effort to keep all the citizens of the county safe do hereby support the current stage 1 fire restrictions in the unincorporated areas of Grant County except for prohibiting the possession of fireworks.

This resolution will stay in place and adjust to match the current fire restrictions until rescinded by the Board of Grant County Commissioners.
