RESOLUTION R09-03

TO IMPOSE TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS

**WHEREAS** the country is currently suffering from a poor economic condition; and,

**WHEREAS** the economy in Grant County has begun to take a downturn with the recent layoffs at the mines; and,

**WHEREAS** the full effects of these layoffs has not yet been felt by Grant County and all the municipalities; and,

**WHEREAS** the economic effects are being felt in the current legislative session with the reduction in new capital and possible de-authorization of previous years capital projects; and,

**WHEREAS** the Commission created a travel committee headed up by Commissioner Miller, to look at the current travel policy and come up with a new policy that would help the county realize cost savings; and,


**WHEREAS** The Commission wishes to be proactive in their approach to provide the best services to county residents and at the same time be fiscally responsible to the residents and employees of Grant County.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Grant County Board of Commissioners in an effort to be fiscally responsible and give the travel committee an opportunity to present a new travel policy, imposes the following travel restriction to be in effect immediately:


1. All out of state travel being paid for by any funds under control of Grant County will be suspended until further notice. If registration is already paid for, the county will seek a refund of the fees.
2. All travel in-state will be reduced to mandatory training and meetings only that has been preapproved by Commissioner Miller.

This resolution will stay in place until rescinded by the Commission adopting a new travel policy presented by the travel committee and will not apply to travel being reimbursed 100% by an outside source.
