4 **A RESOLUTION DECLARING A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE A SAFE,**
5 **RESPECTFUL AND FEAR-FREE ENVIRONMENT, WHICH PROHIBITS BULLYING**
6 **WITHIN GRANT COUNTY OWNED PROPERTY.**

8 **WHEREAS**, the Grant County Board of Commissioners recognizes the fact that
9 bullying is a way of using power aggressively in which a person is subjected to intentional,
10 unwanted and unprovoked hurtful verbal and/or physical actions; and

12 **WHEREAS**, bullying results in the victim feeling oppressed, fearful, distressed, injured
or uncomfortable; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Grant County Board of Commissioners is committed to providing a
safe, respectful and fear-free environment for all individuals on Grant County owned property.

15 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Grant County Board of County
16 Commissioners declares a commitment to provide a safe, respectful and fear-free environment,
17 which prohibits bullying for all individuals on Grant County owned property.

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the Grant County Manager is hereby directed to
19 develop and implement anti-bullying regulations and training to eliminate bullying in all Grant
20 County owned property.

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** Grant County Staff shall revise existing
22 agreements with parties who utilize County owned facilities to include a provision that addresses
23 the obligation to comply with all County regulations regarding anti-bullying.
