WHEREAS, the salaries of elected officials are regulated according to New Mexico States Statutes; and,

WHEREAS, Section 4-44-4.1 NMSA 1978 establishes a maximum salary for the elected county offices of Assessor, Clerk, Commissioner, Sheriff, Treasurer and Probate Judge; and,


WHEREAS, the salaries of the elected officials of Grant County have not been increased since January 2005 and are well below the statutorily prescribed maximum salaries; and


WHEREAS, the Grant County Board of Commissioners has determined that the salaries of the elected officials of Grant County will be set at the maximum statutorily prescribed amount; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Grant County Board of Commissioners, that effective January 1, 2011, the elected officials be brought to the maximum statutory level set forth in Section 4-44-4.1 NMSA 1978.



4-44-4.1 . Class B counties; over three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000) valuation; salaries. The annual salaries of elected officers of class B counties with an assessed valuation of over three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000) shall not exceed:

- A. county commissioners, twenty-two thousand eight hundred thirty-two dollars (\$22,832) each;
- B. treasurer, fifty-seven thousand two hundred sixty-five dollars (\$57,265);
- C. assessor, fifty-seven thousand two hundred sixty-five dollars (\$57,265);
- D. sheriff, fifty-nine thousand six hundred ninety-nine dollars (\$59,699);
- E. county clerk, fifty-seven thousand two hundred sixty-five dollars (\$57,265); and
- F. probate judge, twenty thousand twenty-four dollars (\$20,024).
