**WHEREAS**, the salaries of elected officials are regulated according to New Mexico States Statutes; and,


**WHEREAS**, Section 4-44-4.1 NMSA 1978 establishes a maximum salary for the elected county offices of Assessor, Clerk, Commissioner, Sheriff, Treasurer and Probate Judge; and,


**WHEREAS**, the salaries of the elected officials of Grant County have not been increased since January 2005 and are well below the statutorily prescribed maximum salaries; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grant County Board of Commissioners has determined that the salaries of the elected officials of Grant County will be set at the maximum statutorily prescribed amount; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Grant County Board of Commissioners, that effective January 1, 2011, the elected officials be brought to the maximum statutory level set forth in Section 4-44-4.1 NMSA 1978.



**4-44-4.1**

**4-44-4.1 . Class B counties; over three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000) valuation; salaries.**

The annual salaries of elected officers of class B counties with an assessed valuation of over three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000) shall not exceed:

- A. county commissioners, twenty-two thousand eight hundred thirty-two dollars (\$22,832) each;
- B. treasurer, fifty-seven thousand two hundred sixty-five dollars (\$57,265);
- C. assessor, fifty-seven thousand two hundred sixty-five dollars (\$57,265);
- D. sheriff, fifty-nine thousand six hundred ninety-nine dollars (\$59,699);
- E. county clerk, fifty-seven thousand two hundred sixty-five dollars (\$57,265); and
- F. probate judge, twenty thousand twenty-four dollars (\$20,024).
