DESIGNATING TYRONE AS A "COLONIA" WITHIN GRANT COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Grant County Commission wishes to designate Tyrone as a "Colonia" as defined by USDA Rural Development, and

WHEREAS, Tyrone is an unincorporated community in Grant County, and

WHEREAS, the Tyrone water and wastewater system was established in the 1960's, and

WHEREAS, the Tyrone water and wastewater system is aging; and

WHEREAS, Tyrone is in need of water wastewater system improvements, and

WHEREAS, Tyrone meets the definition of a colonia as established by USDA

WHEREAS, Tyrone was in existence prior to October 1, 1989, and

WHEREAS, Tyrone has a population of less than 10,000.



PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED this 18th day of March 2010.





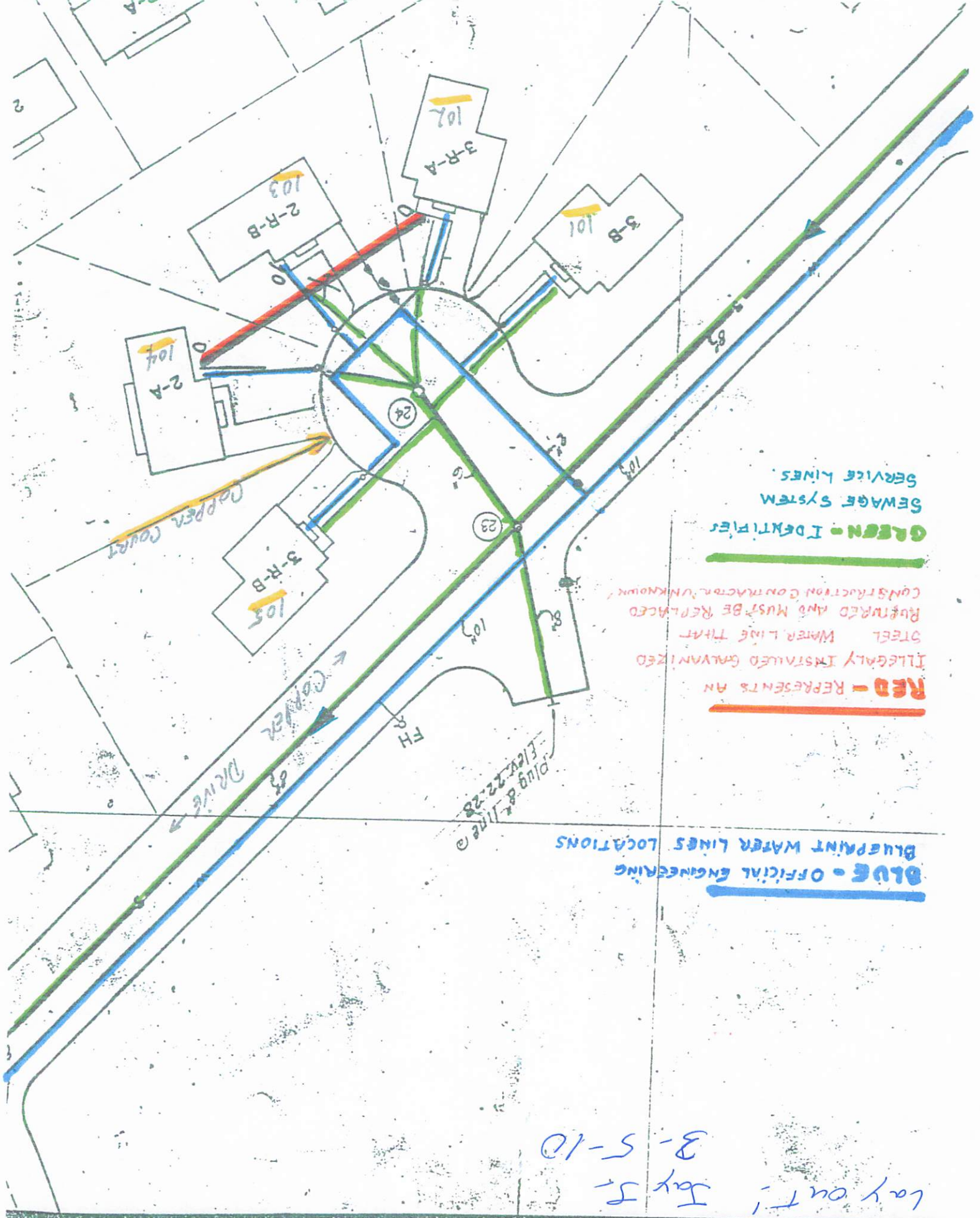
