policy, but a fundamental human entitlement; and


WHEREAS, all citizens have the right to live where they choose within

religion, sex, national origin, disability or family status; and


WHEREAS, the County of Grant acknowledges the importance of assuring

this 8th day of April 2010.






Jovita Gonzales, District 2
