

RESOLUTION #R-10-26

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF GRANT AND THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ROADS WITHIN GRANT COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the County of Grant requests a cooperative agreement with the New Mexico Department of Transportation under the School Bus Routes program to patch and add 2" overlay to existing driving surface with shoulder maintenance and drainage improvements B.O.P. starting .65 miles from Crum Road intersection west .35 miles to E.O.P. and,

WHEREAS, The estimated amount of these projects is \$74,464.00 in which the NMDOT will fund \$55,848.00 (75%) and the county will match \$18,616.00 (25%). Project# SB - 7717(927)11, Control# HW2 M100206 and,

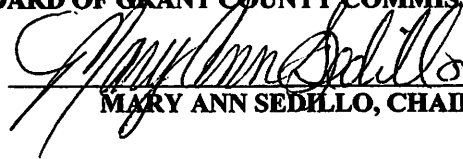
WHEREAS, funds, equipment, labor and materials representing the County's share will be available when the agreement becomes effective, and will remain readily available until agreement is completed or legally terminated, and

WHEREAS, funds representing the County's share of the agreement will be budgeted for, available and payable upon completion of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Grant County Commissioners to enter into a cooperative agreement with the New Mexico Department of Transportation to patch and add a 2" overlay to existing driving surface with shoulder maintenance and drainage improvements. B.O.P. starting .65 miles from Crum Road intersection west .35 miles to E.O.P.
