ELECTED OFFICIALS SALARIES

WHEREAS, the salaries of elected officials are regulated according to New Mexico States Statutes; and,

WHEREAS, Section 4-44-4.1 NMSA 1978 establishes a maximum salary for the elected county offices of Assessor, Clerk, Commissioner, Sheriff, Treasurer and Probate Judge; and,


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County, which is the governing body thereof, to raise the salaries for the elected officials in Grant County, effective January 1, 2015.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Grant County Board of Commissioners, pursuant to state law that the salaries to be paid to elected officials of Grant County shall be as follows:

- 1) Effective January 1, 2015, the salary for the Sheriff will be \$ 65,273.59; Assessor will be \$ 62,643.79; Probate Judge will be \$ 21,911.38; and Commission District 1 and 2 will be \$ 24,960.16.
- 2) Effective January 1, 2017, the salary for Clerk will be \$ 62,643.79; Treasurer will be \$ 62,643.79; Commission District 3 will be \$ 24,960.16

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no salary increase shall take effect until the first day of the term of an elected county official who takes office on or after January 1, 2015.
