RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AND ADOPT THE 2014 GRANT COUNTY
EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN

WHEREAS, the toll on families and individuals can be immense, and damaged businesses cannot contribute to the economy; and

WHEREAS, the time, money, and effort spent to respond to and recover from these disasters divert public resources and attention from other important problems and programs; and


WHEREAS, Grant County, New Mexico recognizes the consequences of disasters and the need to respond quickly to reduce the impacts of natural and human-caused hazards; and

WHEREAS, this plan was prepared in accordance with local responsibilities to meet the requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Authority (FEMA) guide for Comprehensive Preparedness Guide, Developing and Maintaining Emergency Operation Plans, (CPG 101); and




