REVISION TO THE GRANT COUNTY RETURN TO WORK
AND MODIFIED DUTY POLICY, IN RELATION TO THE GRANT COUNTY
DETENTION CENTER

WHEREAS, Grant County adopted its current Return to Work and Modified Duty Policy ("Policy") June 13, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Policy has been successful for the most part, benefitting both Grant County and its employees; and


WHEREAS, the Policy has, unfortunately, not been successful in the Grant County Detention Center due to the substantial financial cost it imposes on that department; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that having a Return to Work and Modified Duty in the Detention Center is cost prohibitive.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that in light of the interests described herein, officers employed at the Grant County Detention Center shall no longer be eligible for the Grant County Return to Work and Modified Duty Policy, and instead will need a full medical release to be eligible to return to work after an injury.


